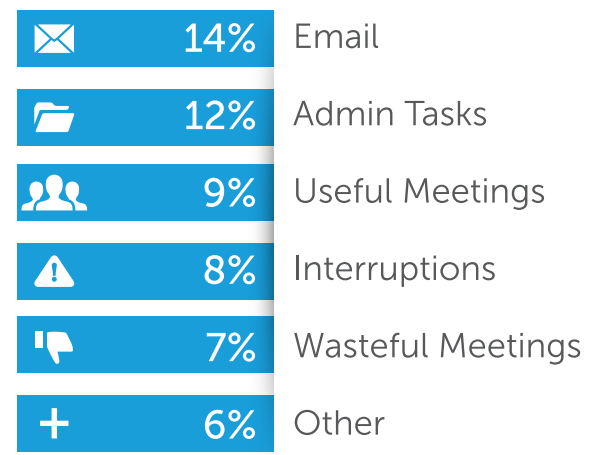
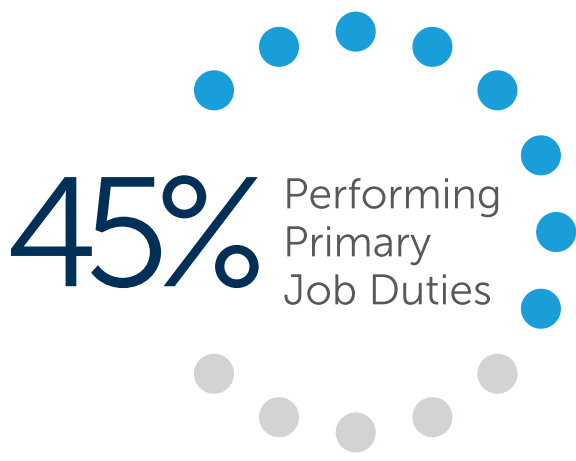


# Office Productivity: A Work in Progress

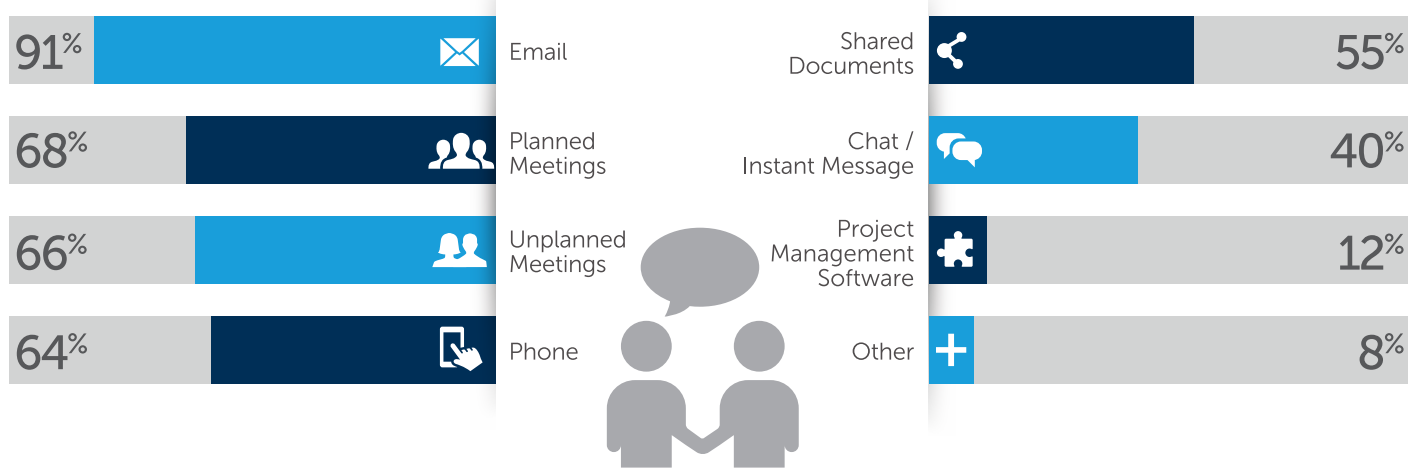
An annual study of office workers shows the struggle for productivity is very real. Here are some insights into their unseen struggles.

The average office worker spends more than half of their time on activities outside of their primary job duties.

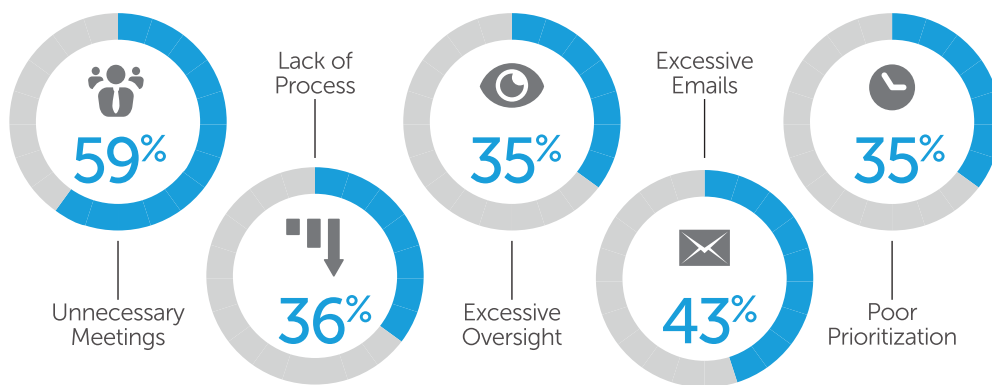


## How do office workers communicate?



Despite numerous options, many workers are slow to adopt newer communication methods—preferring to stick with familiar choices like email.

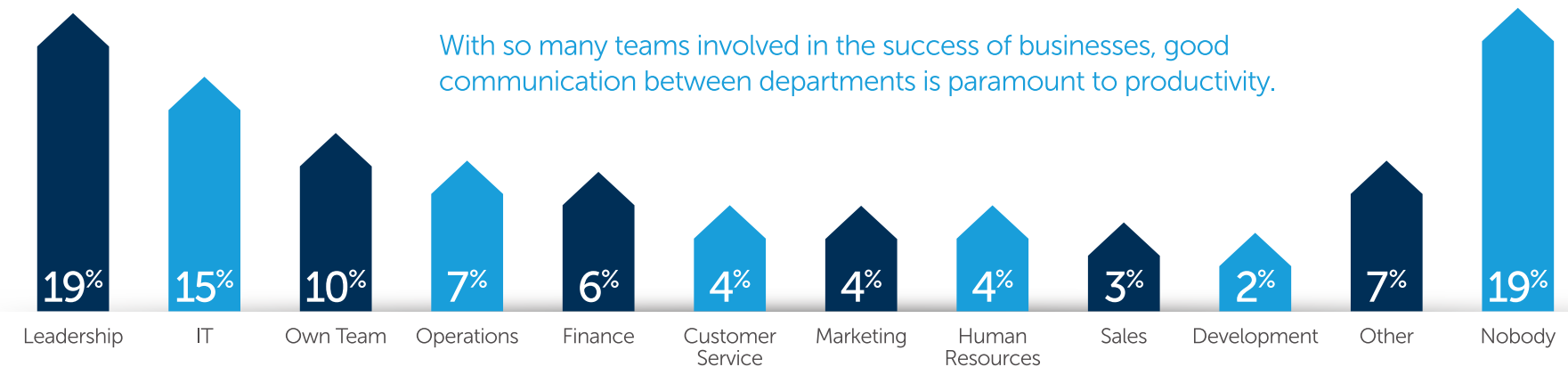
Sometimes the very tools and activities designed to boost productivity actually become barriers to it. Choose carefully and implement purposefully.

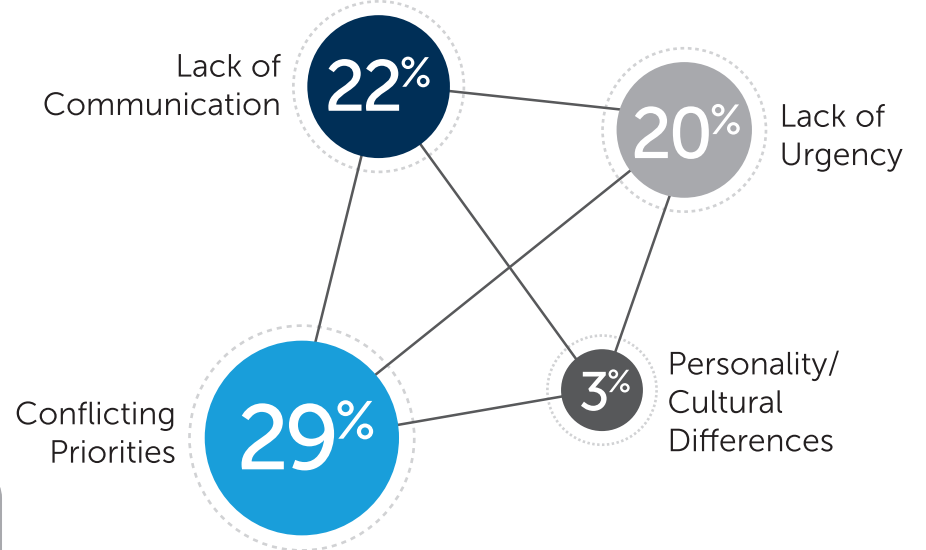
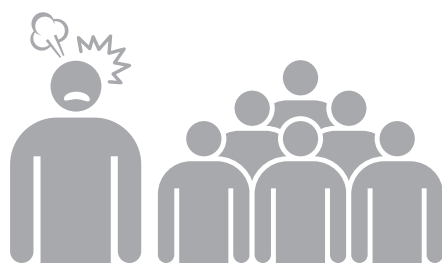
## Who are workers butting heads with most?

With so many teams involved in the success of businesses, good communication between departments is paramount to productivity.

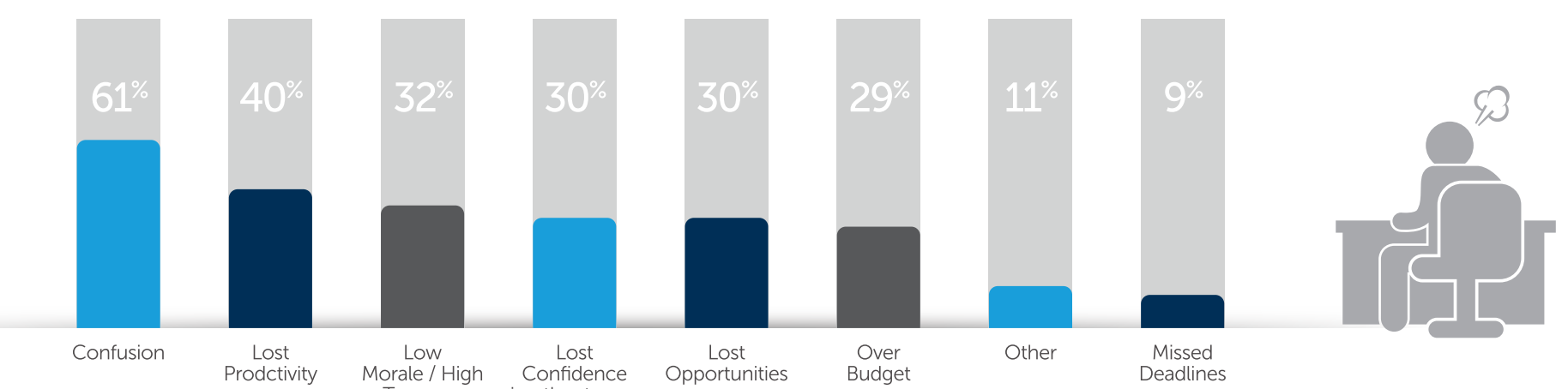


## Why do workers have conflict with other groups?
